**MHESAC/SAF Award \$1,500 in Rebates to Lucky Borrowers**

(HELENA) Three lucky borrowers recently received student loan rebates of \$500 apiece from Montana Higher Education Student Assistance Corporation (MHESAC) and Student Assistance Foundation (SAF) as thanks for their participation in an online customer service survey.

Montana residents Cynthia Sologub and Arden Smith, both of Helena, and New York resident Marzena Romanski, of Maspeth, were selected at random from a pool of 2,029 customers whose loans are serviced by SAF who responded to a survey aimed at evaluating the quality of service provided to borrowers.

“Customer service is critical to the work we perform at MHESAC and SAF,” said Joan Lewis, loan servicing manager for SAF. “We are reviewing the suggestions we received in the survey in an effort to ensure our customers are receiving the assistance they need at all times.
